The following are the action items from the meeting:

May Bike Expo

- Jason G. provided an update on the event and stated 21 bikes were sold, 41 bikes were registered and 80 bike expo t-shirts were handed out.
- Ken K. provided an update and thanked all of the Committee members who volunteered for the event and 48 ROLL Model Pledges were signed.
- There was a lot of positive feedback about the event from parents who participated with their kids.
- Group discussion on considerations for future bike expo events were; possibly changing day and time of event, place #'s at each of the skills course stations, try to get more involvement from middle school and high school aged kids, include a separate area for kids to ride their bikes while not completing skills course stations, have a 'mini' bike expo at other times of the year, encourage more participation from parents to walk/ride through exercises with their kids, replace the rock dodge skills course with a hazard course and do the bike tour multiple times during the event and not just towards the end.

ACTION ITEMS

- For future events reach out to more groups to try and increase participation, such as Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, school groups, local bicycle athletes.

Sidewalk Assessment/Evaluation Project Update

- Ken K. provided an update the Highway Dept. completed the evaluation of the sidewalks. The data is in the process of being added to the Town's GIS data layers.
- Ken K. provided a presentation to the Committee of the GIS layer, data collected and how it will be used by the Town.
- Ken K. stated the sidewalks and crosswalks were the main focus for this evaluation. An assessment of the curb ramps will be done at a later date.
- The Committee expressed their appreciation for all the work the Highway Department put into doing the evaluation.

ACTION ITEMS

- Sidewalk project for this year is completed. Ken K. will update Committee in the future when curb ramp assessment is to commence.

Haswell Farms/The Enclave Traffic Calming Initiative

- Ken K. provided an update to the Committee on the status of the project. The Town obtained 4 quotes from speed radar sign companies. The Highway Superintendent is in the process of ordering the radar signs. There will be an approximate 30 to 45 day waiting period for delivery from when

signs are ordered. Radar signs, crosswalks and Yield to Pedestrian signs will be installed concurrently.

ACTION ITEMS

- Ken K. will update Committee when signs have been delivered an installation will occur.

New Business

- Ken K. updated the Committee on the Safe Routes To School project for installation of sidewalks on Fernbank Ave, Delmar Place and portion of Adams Street. The Town is coordinating with the BCSD to complete the pre-construction student survey.
- Ken K. mentioned to the Committee the June 22 Summer Solstice event, sponsored by Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy, taking place on the Helderberg Hudson Rail Trail and if any Committee members would like to participate in the event.
- Committee asked if Ken K. could reach out to Officer Mike Whitely and invite to June meeting. Committee is interested in receiving input from Officer Whitely on how to make streets safer for pedestrians.
