This value illustrates connectivity and movement in Bethlehem for both people (vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian modes) and wildlife between centers of public activity and habitat patches, such as recreation and conservation areas, parks and schools, farm stands and markets, and business areas/hamlets. This value shows opportunities for people to move through our town and opportunities for wildlife to move between habitat patches, promoting healthy lifestyles and wildlife biodiversity.
