Include your name, phone number, and confirmation that you have your own kayak, paddle, and personal flotation device. Registration is limited. You will receive a confirmation email to serve as your registration. Confirmed participants should meet at the [Henry Hudson Park Kayak Launch](#) (located at the south end of the park) in time to have your boat in the water for a **prompt paddle start time**.

Participants MUST bring their own kayaks and gear, including personal flotation device, and be proficient paddlers, paddling at their own risk. Kayak leaders will provide the ecological info, but are not boating instructors. *Kayaks, paddles and PFDs can be rented online through www.upstatekayakrentals.com (not affiliated with the Town).*
