PHARMACEUTICAL COLLECTION



Sat., October 24; 10:00 am - 2:00 pm; Elm Avenue Park, 261 Elm Avenue, Delmar (Pool parking lot closest to Route 32).

- Bring expired/unwanted medications
- This will be a “contactless” event where participants place medications in provided receptacles. Please wear masks and maintain distancing
- FREE event. Everyone may participate and program is anonymous
- If disposing in original container, you are encouraged, but not required, to remove identifying information from the label
- Accepted items include prescription and over the counter medications in pill, liquid and powder form
- Controlled and non-controlled substances are accepted
- Intravenous solutions, injectables and needles will NOT be accepted

- FREE event limited to Bethlehem residents with ID ONLY
- Limit of **3 medium sized boxes** of documents per household.
- All participants must wear a mask and maintain adequate social distancing
- Please do NOT bring extra passengers to this event

RECYCLING THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

Clothing and Textiles: Clothing, footwear, and textiles can also be recycled in the bins at the CDTA Elm Ave Park & Ride, the Town Municipal Lot at 407 Kenwood Ave (by Hughes Opticians), the Transfer Station, or with local charitable organizations. See www.townofbethlehem.org/recycling for details.

Electronics: Recycle TVs, computers, printers, monitors, etc. and all cables year-round at the Town’s Rupert Rd Transfer Station. Fees may apply.

Mixed Paper, Cardboard and Books: Recycle at the Town’s Rupert Rd Transfer Station or with private haulers (NOTE: Covers need to be removed before recycling hardcover books)
