Bring your own containers and shovel if shoveling; or truck or trailer for loaded material. NOTE: Masks and social distancing will be required.

Secure Shredding: Limited to Bethlehem residents with ID only (driver’s license, tax or utility bill showing your Town address). Maximum limit of 3 medium boxes of documents per household. [Pre-order composters and rain barrels online](#) by 5/1/21.

RECYCLING THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

Clothing and Textiles: Clothing, footwear, and textiles can also be recycled in the bins at the CDTA Elm Ave Park & Ride, the Town Municipal Lot at 407 Kenwood Ave (by Hughes Opticians), the Transfer Station, or with local charitable organizations. See www.townofbethlehem.org/recycling for details.

Electronics: Recycle TVs, computers, printers, monitors, peripherals, etc. and all cables year-round at the Town’s Rupert Rd Transfer Station. Fees may apply

Mixed Paper, Cardboard and Books: Recycle at the Town’s Rupert Rd Transfer Station (except hardcover books—remove covers to recycle) or with your private hauler. Fees may apply.
