I certify that the SWPPP and all attachments submitted to the Town of Bethlehem were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that a *qualified professional* properly gathered and evaluated the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete.

I fully understand that *qualified professional* means a person that is knowledgeable in the principles and practices of stormwater management and treatment, such as a licensed Professional Engineer, licensed Landscape Architect or other Department endorsed individual(s).

I also understand that it is a violation of Chapter 98 of the Code of the Town of Bethlehem for:

- any person to discharge or cause to be discharged into the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) any material other than stormwater except as noted in § 98-7.A(1)
- any land disturbance activity to cause an increase in turbidity resulting in a substantial visible contrast to background conditions in surface waters of the State of New York.

Furthermore, I understand that certifying false, incorrect or inaccurate information is a violation of the referenced permit and the laws of the State of New York and could subject me to criminal, civil and/or administrative proceedings.

Individuals preparing SWPPPs that require the post-construction stormwater management practice component must have an understanding of the principles of hydrology, water quality management practice design, water quantity control design, and, in many cases, the principles of hydraulics in order to prepare a SWPPP that conforms to the Department's technical standard. All components of the SWPPP that involve the practice of engineering, as defined by the NYS Education Law (Article 145), shall be prepared by, or under the direct supervision of, a professional engineer licensed to practice in the State of New York.

Furthermore, I understand that certifying false, incorrect or inaccurate information is a violation of the referenced permit and the laws of the State of New York and could subject me to criminal, civil and/or administrative proceedings.


