I hereby certify that for the project named below all construction activities identified in the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) have been completed, all areas of disturbance have achieved *final stabilization*, all temporary, structural erosion and sediment control (E&SC) measures have been removed, and all post-construction stormwater management practice (SMP) have been constructed in conformance with the SWPPP and are operational. As defined by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) General Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity (*GP-0-08-001*), or as modified/updated, “*final stabilization*”, means that all soil disturbing activities at the site have ceased and a uniform, perennial vegetative cover with a density of eighty (80) percent over the entire pervious surface has been established; or other equivalent stabilization measures, such as permanent landscape mulches, rock rip-rap or washed /crushed stone have been applied on all previously disturbed areas that are not covered by permanent structures, concrete or pavement.

I hereby certify that these post-construction practices, as detailed in the SWPPP or as specifically authorized for modification by the Town of Bethlehem, have been constructed in general accordance with the design plans and specifications; and appear to be functioning in accordance with their intended use and as required by *GP-0-08-001* and Chapter 98 of the Town Code. I certify an updated operations and maintenance (O&M) plan for all the post-construction E&SC and/or SMPs was submitted to, and approved by, the Town of Bethlehem, Engineering Division.

Furthermore, I understand that certifying false, incorrect or inaccurate information is a violation of the referenced permit and the laws of the State of New York and could subject me to criminal, civil and/or administrative proceedings.
