- Only Town of Bethlehem Residents and pre-registered Town businesses* can participate.
*(Residents do NOT pre-register. *Businesses pre-register by phone: 518-439-4955 x1510)*
- Proof of Residency is a valid New York State Driver's License or current Town tax bill.
- Keep wastes in their original labeled containers. Tighten lids and pack securely in a cardboard box.
- Never mix chemicals. Wrap leaking containers in newspaper and place in plastic bag or container.
- DO NOT smoke near chemicals or leave product in a hot, unventilated vehicle for an extended period of time.
- For your SAFETY, please stay in your car. Workers will unload the material.
- We reserve the right to refuse any material that is deemed unacceptable by the managing chemist.

ACCEPTABLE WASTES

- ▲ Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides
- ▲ Paints (Oil Base, Latex)
- ▲ Wood Preservatives and Stains
- ▲ Thinners, Solvents & Drain Cleaners
- ▲ Swimming Pool Chemicals
- ▲ Gasoline/Kerosene
- ▲ Automotive Fluids/Batteries
- ▲ Cleaning Products; Acids and Bases
- ▲ Asbestos (Wet and Double Bagged)
- ▲ Fluorescent & CFL Light Bulbs
- ▲ Mercury Thermostats & Thermometers
- ▲ TVs, Computers & Electronics

UNACCEPTABLE

- ▼ Empty Paint Cans
(remove lid & throw in trash)
- ▼ Empty Aerosols (trash)
- ▼ Explosives/Ammunition
- ▼ Fireworks
- ▼ Radioactive Material
- ▼ Controlled Substances
- ▼ Known Dioxins
- ▼ Compressed Gases
- ▼ Commercial Waste
- ▼ Industrial/Medical Waste
- ▼ Freon Appliances (bring to Transfer Station)
