American Rescue Funds Update – provided by Supervisor VanLuven

-Total was \$3.5M. Board to discuss during 6/22 meeting

Amounts proposed include:

-\$60K for Education Campaign (two firms interviewed today by Town Staff)

-\$60K for Kenwood Ave Assessment

-\$6K for engineering study, re: 3 homes, right of way and improving safety

-\$600-700K on sidewalks!!! To be spent by 2026.

-> One approach is non-state roads first, then state roads

## Sidewalk Updates

-Feura Bush Road project has a cost holdup due to possible error and high cost of concrete

-Skip provided 12 min presentation, which was emailed to this committee

-graphs in presentation show time needed to repair current sidewalks and keep up (impossible)

-the promise of increased funds will help make a phenomenal dent for our community

## Speed Humps

-DVL will pull together a fact sheet to highlight benefits of this speed curbing strategy

-Brockley Drive is a possible test site, perhaps Kenaware too.

-Steve mentioned these may be portable, cost is low (around \$700 per hump), says humps in Voorheesville appear to be permanent
