



## Boat Launch Rules & Courtesy Guidelines

# Welcome to the Bethlehem Boat Launch !



## Courtesy at the Boat Launch

- \*Prepare your boat before approaching the ramp area. Load gear. Do not block the ramp.
- \*If possible, use two people to launch and retrieve the boat. One to operate the tow vehicle and one to operate the boat.
- \*Ensure your engine will start while the boat is still on the trailer.
- \*Encourage passengers to wait ashore while launching. Do not congregate on the docks.
- \*After launching, move your boat and tow vehicle away from the launch area as soon as possible.
- \*Vehicles without trailers must not occupy parking spaces designated for trailers. No parking on the grass.
- \*After retrieving your boat, prepare it for the trip home in an area away from the ramp.

## Launch Rules

- \*The ramp area is for launching and retrieving boats only. No fishing from docks. No docking except

immediately after launching and immediately prior to retrieving your boat.

\*When retrieving or launching your boat, the order is formed by vehicles lined up with trailers, not by boats in the water.

\*Observe and understand the established launching and retrieval traffic flow patterns before using the launch.

\*If there is an attendant on duty, follow their directions so as to ensure the safe and expeditious use of the launch ramp.
