



# *Information & Directions to other Parks from Elm Avenue Park*

**HENRY HUDSON PARK**-This park is located along the Hudson River off of Route 144. It offers a pavilion which seats approximately 150 people, a volleyball net, a horseshoe pit, gazebo, boat launch, playground, softball field and restrooms. The pavilion may be reserved by organizations based in the Town of Bethlehem and Bethlehem residents, by contacting the Parks and Recreation office. Fees vary depending on the size of the group.

**Directions to Henry Hudson Park from Elm Avenue Park:** Go straight through light at park entrance to Feura Bush Road, left on Feura Bush Road. Turn right onto Wemple Road and cross Route 9W and continue on Wemple Road to the end. Take a right onto Route 144 and continue south on Route 144 for approximately 2 miles. Take a left on Barent-Winne Road. Continue on Barent-Winne, road forks, bear to the right down the hill to Henry Hudson Park.

**SOUTH BETHLEHEM PARK**-This park is located on Wylie Lane. It includes a playground, basketball court, picnic tables, softball field, soccer field and volleyball net.

**Directions to South Bethlehem Park from Elm Avenue Park:** From Elm Avenue Park proceed 2.8 miles South on Route 32. Take a left on County Route 102 (Old Quarry Road). Proceed 1.7 miles and take a left on County Route 54/53 (South Albany Road). Go 2.6 miles and take a left on Wylie Lane.

**NORTH BETHLEHEM PARK**-This park is located off of Russell Road and has a playground, basketball court and picnic tables.

**Directions to North Bethlehem Park from Elm Avenue Park:** From Elm Avenue Park go north on Elm Avenue, Cherry Avenue and the Slingerlands by-pass extension (Route 140). Enter roundabout and take first exit. Take a left at the light. Enter roundabout and take first exit. Travel up to the next roundabout and take second exit onto Blessing Road. Take Blessing Road to the end and take a left onto Krumkill Road. Take your first right, which is Russell Road. North Bethlehem Park is on the left approximately 2/10 of a mile.

**BETHLEHEM FIREFIGHTERS PARK**-This pocket park, located next to the Slingerlands Fire House, features a memorial to all Bethlehem firefighters and a large grass play area.

**Directions to Bethlehem Firefighters Park from Elm Avenue Park:** North on Elm Avenue and Cherry Avenue. Left on Kenwood Avenue to first traffic light. Sharp right at the light onto New Scotland Road. Park is just past the Slingerlands Fire House on the right.

**SELKIRK PARK**-This area has 2 tennis courts, a basketball court and a very small playing field (for kids only), a playground with swings, picnic tables and drinking water is available.

**Directions to Selkirk Park from Elm Avenue Park:** Right onto Route 32. Left on Creble Road to Route 9W. Right on 9W to Route 396, left on Route 396 to Thatcher Street. Right on Thatcher Street. Left on Houck Lane.

**MAPLE RIDGE PARK**-This park is located on Elm Avenue East, off of Elm Avenue. It features a pavilion which seats up to 75 people, a playground, large grass areas, a basketball court and picnic areas.

**Directions to Maple Ridge Park from Elm Avenue Park:** Go straight through light at park entrance. Cross Feura Bush Road at the 4 way stop sign. Bear left on Elm Avenue East. Continue to Maple Ridge Park on the left.

**MOH-HE-CON-NUCK NATURE PRESERVE**-This preserve, located on Route 144 in historic Cedar Hill, features a network of trails.

**Directions to MHCN Nature Preserve from Elm Avenue Park:** Go straight through light at park entrance to Feura Bush Road, left on Feura Bush Road. Turn right onto Wemple Road and cross Route 9W and continue on Wemple Road to the end. Take a right onto Route 144 and continue south on Route 144 for approximately 1.5 miles.
