Each ID Kit gives parents an easy-to-use compact kit with instructions to record and maintain a complete identification record of their child.

Each ID Kit includes: a child identification fingerprinting kit, a <u>GenetiKid DNA Isolation</u> <u>Card</u>, a plastic protective sleeve, two sterile cotton swabs, a place for a photograph, dental information, physical information, complete instructions for parents.

It's now even easier to collect and store your child's genetic material - a simple swab, a space-age storage membrane, and no freezing required makes this the simplest, safest genetic sample storage method ever.
