Full Service: Attendant on site and loader operator available to load compost. Users may purchase compost and drop off waste. Non-resident and Commercial users may only utilize the facility during Full Service hours.



Self Service: Residents may drop off waste and shovel compost. No attendant or loader available.



Facility Closed: Access is restricted to authorized personnel only.

About: The Town of Bethlehem's Compost Facility provides an ecologically responsible way of processing the yard waste and organics generated by Town residents into high quality compost and mulch products. These products help build healthy, beautiful landscapes and reduce greenhouse gas emissions in our fight against climate change. The facility is open to the public, and accepts yard waste for drop-off (tipping fees apply to businesses and non-residents). Food scraps are currently only accepted from local haulers by appointment with advanced permission (tipping fees apply).

Compost Products: Screened Compost, Enhanced Screened Compost, Leaf Compost and Wood Mulch (in two types) are available at the Compost Facility for residents, non-residents and commercial users. Dropping Yard Waste: Town Residents may drop off yard waste for FREE (up to 4 yards/week) during full service and self service days. Commercial users may only drop off yard waste during full service days at a rate of \$10/yard.
